DEADDICTION ROLE PLAYS AT ALCOHOL DEADDICTION CAMPAIGN

Alcohol is injurious not just to the health of the individual and his family but to the community as a whole. Realising the ripples of problems that alcohol addiction can create, the honourable chairman of Velammal educational trust, decided to initiate a campaign against alcohol addiction in Pappankulam village in Sivagangai district. As the first step of this campaign, a Community Health awareness programme was organised by the Department of Community Medicine, Velammal Medical College Hospital and Research Institute, Madurai on 19.11.17, between 6 PM and 8 PM. The event opened with the enthusiastic parai aatam by Indian Kalai kuzhu followed by the official inauguration of the event by the local leaders of village, Mr. Muthukamatchi and Mr. Muniyandi.

Dr. Samir Bele, Head of Department of Community Medicine, Dr. John Rajpathy, Professor of Physiology at Velammal Medical College were among the dignitaries who graced the occasion. Dr. Ramanujam, Head of Department of Psychiatry at Velammal Medical College Hospital enlightened the audience about the harmful effects of alcohol addiction. He also introduced the audience to the services and facilities available at the Nambikkai de-addiction centre at Velammal Hospital. A beneficiary of the services was present in the audience to share his story of how he successfully came free from the clutches of alcohol addiction with the help of the able team at Nambikkai de-addiction centre. Undergraduate medical students from Velammal Medical College presented a short film directed and performed by the students themselves, emphasising the fatal effects that alcohol addiction can have. They also performed a skit before the audience to stress upon how deaddiction can positively influence the health and wellbeing of the individual and the community. The event, which was attended by over 500 villagers including women and children, came to a conclusion with the soulful performance of parai aatam. This is the first of the many planned events by Velammal Medical College to target alcohol addiction problem in the community.

It was grandeur and pride the 6th batch of batch of MBBS students were welcomed into the Velammal family. On August 10th 2019 the Inauguration program started at 10:35 am. All students with their parents were present. Following welcome address by the Dean a short discourse on the Vision of the Velammal institutions was rendered by the CEO and all the Heads of the departments were introduced by the MS. The Honorable Chairman of the Velammal educations trust gave the presidential address following which they were interactions with the parents.

The second day the session started at 8:00 am with ice breaking. Dr. John Rajpathy the MEU coordinator introduced the concept of foundation course, the vice principal set the tone for the course. Dr. Rena Assc prof. Psychiatry and Dr.Yegu.Assc.ProfPathology engaged the students with introductions and Team building exercises. Teams were formed and were given model building tasks with paper.
