#### **Activity Report**

#### Suicide Prevention and Psychological First Aid

#### Introduction:

The burden of Suicide in our society is humungous. Globally, close to 8 lakh people die by suicide every year, that's one person every 40 seconds. For each suicide, there are more than 20 suicide attempts.

While the causes of suicide are many, with mental illnesses being at the forefront, many suicides are impulsive and in the heat of the moment during times of stress and crises.

Risk factors include experience of loss, loneliness, discrimination, a relationship break-up, financial problems, chronic pain and illness, violence, abuse, and conflict or other humanitarian emergencies. The strongest risk factor for suicide is a previous suicide attempt.

In India, pesticides, self-hanging, jumping off bridges and in front of trains are the major means by which suicide is attempted.

The Mental Healthcare Act, 2017 decriminalizes suicide, assuring adequate medical relief to those attempting it. This is a landmark development ensuring dignity and a humane perspective to the issue and has helped reduce the stigma attached to it.

The key to addressing suicides is to create awareness about its prevention, management and enhance the capacity of health workers to offer first-aid.

#### Objective:

- 1. The course aims at enhancing awareness among the medical students / staff about the burden of suicide and train them in the basics of Psychological First Aid.
- 2. At the end of the course the students are able to possess knowledge regarding the Psychological interventions for Suicide.

Topic Name: Pulmonary function test

Introduction: The condition of the lungs can be assessed by pulmonary function tests. There are a variety of testes which can be used to evaluate the anatomical, physiological and pathological state of the respiratory system. The most common device used for measuring pulmonary functions is spirometer. Hence a complete knowledge about the pulmonary function tests and the usage of spirometry in daily basis becomes essential. Hence this program is aimed at developing the basic knowledge about spirometric techniques and the other commonly used lung function tests.

**Description:** Department of Physiology, Velammal Medical College Hospital and Research Institute, Madurai, Tamilnadu in association with Departments of Anatomy, Biochemistry, Pulmonary medicine and Radiology had organised a certifiable value-added course to First Professional MBBS students (2020-21 batch) on 30 and 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021.

The program spanned for 16 hours of duration covering the salient aspects and importance of Pulmonary function tests. Eminent speakers from various departments gave talks on the core concept of Pulmonology correlated with pulmonary function tests, its interpretation and their clinical importance apart from what they have learnt in their regular curriculum and practical sessions. A pretest was conducted before the session comprising of 30 MCQs.

In the second day afternoon, clinical case study PFT values were discussed with students. Students were able to solve the values by themselves arriving in a provisional diagnosis. Students, after the completion of the course were able to interpret the pulmonary function test reports in their clinical practice and were able to effectively handle the respiratory pathology in real life. To access the improvement in the knowledge of students, post test was also conducted at the end of day 2.

Faculties from the departments of anatomy and physiology took classes about the functional anatomy of the lungs followed by the physiological activity of the respiratory system. This was followed by a session on the biochemical aspects of pulmonary function tests by the faculties of the department of biochemistry. Then the process of collection of pleural fluid for biochemical analysis was demonstrated. With that session day one was concluded. On day two, the faculties discussed the common clinical conditions and their clinical examination details. This was followed by the common pulmonary function tests' demonstration and the interpretation of the values of those tests by the faculties from the department of pulmonary medicine. With that session day two was concluded.

**Outcome Analysis:** There was a post-test session which was followed by a feedback session.



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

Certified programmed on" Problem Solving Methodology and Decision Making" was celebrated in velammal medical college on 20 & 21st sep 2020.


