Procedure: VMCH & RI works to expose both students and faculty to understand about various insurance schemes and aware about the legalities in the insurance field.


The faculty and students are aware with the numerous Indian Penal Code (IPC) and Criminal Penal Code (CrPC) requirements that medical practitioners must deal with.

During orientation programme, students are introduced with the medicolegal aspects and documentation.

Teaching session has been arranged for the faculty members to make them familiar with medical indemnity insurance schemes.

In teaching and learning sessions, special recommendations are made in compliance with the suggestions stated in competency-based medical education. This can be accomplished through a variety of programmes, including lectures on the medicolegal aspects of insurance, group discussions on third-party insurance continuing medical education, symposiums on various insurance schemes, and third-party insurance.

Indemnity insurance for clinical faculties for senior residents and above. By providing indemnity insurance to clinical faculties helps to improve faculty trust and loyalty towards the Institute.
