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Informed Consent Process in Clinical Research

Report

The program started with the participants being provided with a pre-test questionnaire to assess their knowledge on ethical principles in clinical research.

Dr. Muthu Meera MD, Tutor at the Department of Pharmacology, VMCHRI, Madurai, commenced the program by delivering a comprehensive presentation on ethical principles in clinical research. Dr. Meera discussed the importance of ethical considerations in conducting research and highlighted key principles such as respect for autonomy, beneficence, non-maleficence, and justice.

Dr. Raj Kishore Mahato MD, Professor & Head of the Department of Pharmacology, VMCHRI, Madurai, took the stage and presented an in-depth session on informed consent. Participants learned about the significance of obtaining informed consent from research participants, the elements of informed consent, and the process of obtaining it ethically and legally.

Dr. Sindhu MD, Assistant Professor at the Department of Pharmacology, VMCHRI, Madurai, addressed the topic of consent for research in special circumstances. Dr. Sindhu discussed the unique challenges and considerations involved in obtaining informed consent from vulnerable populations or individuals with limited capacity to provide consent. The session included case studies and examples to facilitate a deeper understanding of the subject.

The program concluded with an interactive discussion session, allowing participants to share their thoughts, ask questions, and engage in a constructive dialogue with the speakers and fellow attendees. Following the discussion, participants were given a post-test questionnaire to evaluate their knowledge gained from the program.



This report provides an overview of the ISO training program conducted in our institution over a period of two days. The purpose of the training was to familiarize participants with the ISO standards and their implementation within our organization. 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








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
