





#### **Activities:**

 The first session was about Government, Law, and Ethics and Health care ethics. Information about a patient's medical condition is considered private.

Then Dean spoke on violating a patient's confidentiality can hurt the patient and have legal and ethical consequences for the health care worker.

- In order for any medical treatment to be considered legal, the patient must first provide the health care worker with an informed consent.
- Forensic medicine HOD emphasised on us moving into an era that will


