The workshop was conducted exclusively for interms to develop basic surgical skill. The interms were trained in suturing and knotting techniques. Hands on training using suture boards were given to them.



Paediatric Emergency Medicine Course for CRRIs

CRRIs are taught on Paediatric Emergency Management. Facility based care of sick children is an important priority. Undergraduates learn adequate knowledge in the management of Pediatric emergencies during the student period. Acquiring skills and competencies to tackle a real emergency situation need to be taught in small groups. This process will need simulations and skills labs. Team skills also need to be taught using the simulated emergency scenarios.

CRRIs will have the postings in Paediatrics for 30 days, in twelve batches throughout the year. The small group will consist of 12 CRRIs. The Skills teaching sessions are held between 2-3 PM everyday. Important Paediatric emergencies are completed in 30 days. The sessions are repeated every month for the subsequently posted batch of CRRIs.

The list of the Paediatric Emergencies sessions conducted every month are attached. Ultimately all the CRRIs are covered in the PEMC Skills Teaching Course every year. This was started in the year 2018 with the first batch of CRRIs (2013 batch) and continued till date.

This skills training course increases the professional skills and employability. These sessions are done by all the faculties of Department of Paediatrics, Velammal Medical College Hospital.


