Introduction

The Department of Pharmacology at VMCH&RI organized a one-day certificate course on "Drug Development and Approval Process" to provide second-year MBBS students with an in-depth understanding of drug development, regulatory approval, and post-marketing processes. The program was designed to supplement the students' pharmacology curriculum and enhance their knowledge of critical processes involved in bringing new drugs to market.

Program Objectives

- 1. To introduce students to the fundamental stages of drug development and clinical trials.
- 2. To familiarize students with preclinical and clinical trial requirements.
- 3. To discuss the regulatory and ethical considerations in drug development.
- 4. To highlight the importance of pharmacovigilance and post-marketing surveillance.
- 5. To engage students through case studies and interactive workshops.

Session Summaries

1. Welcome and Introduction

5. Serious Adverse Event Reporting

8. Post-Marketing Surveillance and Pharmacovigilance

Dr. Susila highlighted the importance of post-marketing surveillance, the role of pharmacovigilance systems, and ongoing monitoring to detect rare adverse effects after a drug is marketed.

9. Ethical and Legal Aspects in Drug Development

Dr. Anitha discussed the ethical challenges and legal considerations in drug research, focusing on patient consent, confidentiality, and compliance with regulatory guidelines.

10. Interactive Workshop: Designing a Hypothetical Drug Trial

The final session was an interactive workshop where all faculty members engaged students in designing a hypothetical drug trial. Students worked in groups to set objectives, define endpoints, and address ethical considerations, enhancing their understanding of the clinical trial process.

Conclusion

The certificate course was well-received, with students showing keen interest in the drug development process and the complexities of regulatory approval. The interactive format and case study discussions provided practical insights, while the workshop encouraged active participation and critical thinking.
