REPORT OF EVENT:

Globally, an estimated 7.36 crore women (nearly one in three) experience physical and/or sexual violence from a partner or non-partner. Violence against women remains a major barrier to achieving equality, development, and peace, as well as to upholding the human rights of women and girls, so International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women is honoured on 25 th November to emphasize that violence against women and girls can be avoided and its negative. As part of this year's theme "Orange the World in 16 Days", the awareness activity was conducted as a part of the worldwide activities by UN country offices and civil society organizations strive to highlight efforts to prevent and end violence against women and girls.
