





Guest Lecture cum Physiology Gold Medal Practical Viva Voce examination

The department of Physiology had organized the Physiology Gold Medal practical viva voce examination on 27.01.2024 for the first year MBBS students of 2022-2023 batch.

Process of selection of finalists for the medal practical exam:

The criteria to appear for the medal exam was kept as scoring above 65 % in two Internal Assessment (IA) Exams. Preliminary MCQ test was conducted for 15 willing I MBBS students. Based on the scores, the 1st 10 students were selected. In the second round, theory examination was conducted for the 10 students. The theory paper were set and evaluated by Dr. S. Anu, Professor & Head, Department of Physiology, Velammal medical college. Minimum qualification marks was 50%. The first three students were selected based on their scores.

The day (27.1.23) started with practical exam in the Hematology lab for all the 3 students at 8.15 am. Hematology topics were RBC count (Major experiment).





The clinical topics were Motor system examination (Major) and Examination of precordium and Examination of respiratory system (Minor). The smooth conduct of the exam was helped and monitored by present MBBS batch volunteers along with the Dr. Noel Naveen Johnson, Senior Resident. Dr. M. Saravanan, Assistant Professor, Department of Physiology, AIIMS Madurai checked the case sheet by 10.00 am.

By 9 am, the program started with welcome address and introduction of Guest speaker by Dr. Ajit Kumar J.T. Dr. M. Saravanan gave a guest lecture on the topic "Basics in basic medical instruments"...

This was then followed by the felicitation of 13 students of 2022-23 batch who secured honors in the University examination. A Certificate was awarded for each student. Few students' parents also graced the occasion. Dr. M. Saravanan felicitated the students.

The gold medal practical viva voce started with the picking of student's lots. Student Ms.Sulocchana Alias Aiswharya S S B K had the opportunity of being the 1st student to attend viva-voce in the lecture hall in front of around 150 students. Totally 3 sets of questions were asked which include hematology and clinical questions. Each of contained 5 questions and each set were of increasing difficulty. While the first person was being questioned the other two were kept in separate rooms and monitored by volunteers. The same sets of questions were repeated for the subsequent participants Mr. Abed Adnan Nazar and Mr. A. A. R. Vimal in order. Three 1st MBBS students volunteered as subjects (SUDEEP U, VARJITHAA J and SANJAY K) for clinical examination. At the end of all 3 sessions the answers for the questions were discussed by Dr. M. Saravanan.

Before the announcement of the results, Dr. M. Saravanan was felicitated by our HOD Dr. S. Anu. Finally results were announced. Ms. Sulocchana Alias Aiswharya S S B K won the 1st place (Gold medal) with Mr. Abed Adnan Nazar and Mr. A. A. R. Vimal receiving 2nd (Silver medal) and 3rd places (Bronze Medal). The students were honored with medals and certificate by Dr. Rajendran, HOD & Professor, Department of Microbiology and Dr. Ramesh, Professor, Department of Microbiology and the guest speaker Dr. Saravanan.
