The Department of Physiology organized the **Physiology Gold Medal Practical Examination & Viva Voce** on 11.11.2024 for the first year MBBS students of 2024 batch.

Process of selection of students for the medal practical exam:

The criterion to appear for the medal exam was kept as scoring above 65% in all the Internal Assessment (IA) exams conducted by the department. Preliminary MCQ test was attempted by for 37 students who fit the criterion. Based on the scores of the MCQ test, top scoring 11 students were selected for the second round. The second round was written examination, questions for which was set by Dr. Prem Balaguru, Associate Professor, Department of Physiology, GMC Ramnathapuram, the chief examiner for this year's gold medal examination and evaluated by Dr. S. Anu, Professor & Head, Department of Physiology, VMCH & RI. The top scoring 3 students were selected for the Practical Examination and Viva Voce. The students were

The Gold Medal practical viva voce started with the picking of lots by the students. 3 sets of questions of increasing difficulty levels were asked in haematology. Each main question contained a subset of 3 questions each. Each student was also asked to perform 3 OSCEs. While the first person was being questioned the other two were kept in separate rooms and monitored by volunteers. The same sets of questions were repeated for the subsequent participants.
