



Poster Competition

For 2024 – 2025 batch

A poster competition was conducted on the topic "POLLUTION" for the first year MBBS students of **2024 - 2025 batch** on **18th November, 2024 (Monday, 04:00 PM to 05:00 PM)** in the Department of Physiology, Velammal Medical College building. This poster competition was conducted as part of **the National Pollution Control Day on December 2nd**, **2024**.

All 150 students were divided into groups of 10. They were asked to prepare either a Physical Poster or an E-Poster. The following table contains topics given to the students.

The students were given time and space to create their posters in the Amphibian lab of the Department of Physiology between 4pm to 4.45pm after college timings.

On the day of the competition the physical posters of the students were hung in the Amphibian lab of the Department of Physiology to be judged. The E-Posters were presented in Lecture Hall 1 of VMC building.

Dr. Trupti Bodhare, Professor and Head, Department of Community Medicine, AIIMS – Madurai was the Chief Guest and Judge for this competition.





The students presented their posters and explained it in various ways and formats. Dr. Trupti Bodhare was asking the students questions to assess their understanding of their topics.

Following the judging process the students were made to assemble in Lecture Hall 1. Dr. John Rajpathy, Professor, Department of Physiology, gave the formal welcome address. Dr. Trupti spoke to the students about pollution and encouraged the students to participate in various competitions organized by their alma mater and other institutions.

Following this the results of the competition were announced, and the certificates were distributed by Chief Guest. The program ended with vote of thanks, delivered by Dr. Noel Naveen Johnson and presentation of a memento and certificate of appreciation to the chief guest by Dr. S. Anu, Professor and Head, Department of Physiology.
