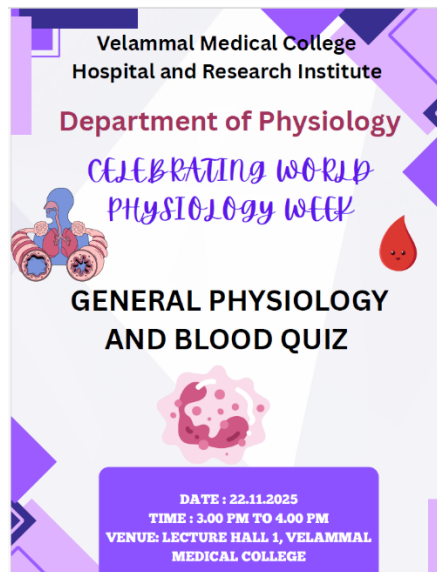




GENERAL PHYSIOLOGY AND BLOOD QUIZ



As part of celebrations of World Physiology Week, the department of Physiology conducted a Quiz competition on the topic general physiology and blood on 22.11.2025 between 03.00PM and 04.00PM in Lecture Hall 1, VMC building.

15 students (5 teams - 3 students in each team) were selected based on their first internal assessment marks. One student from each team came to pick the lot and team were named accordingly as A, B, C, D and E. The program started with a welcome address by Dr. M. Renu Meena, Assistant Professor, Department of Physiology, VMCH & RI.

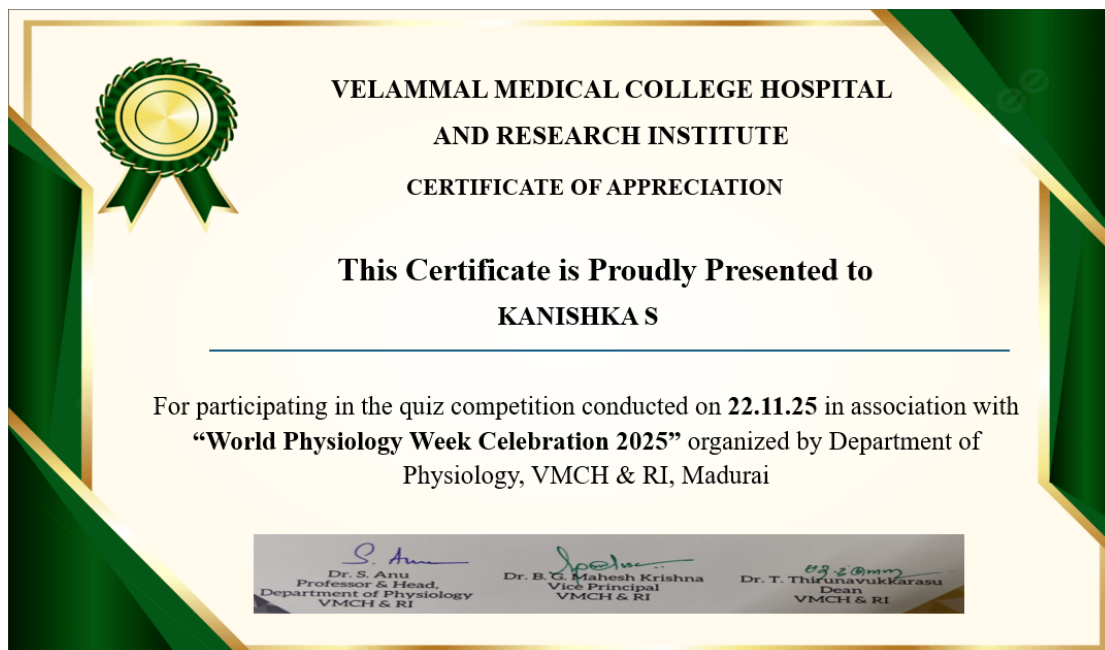


We also conducted a meme competition on behalf of world physiology week, and certificates was given to the winners.
