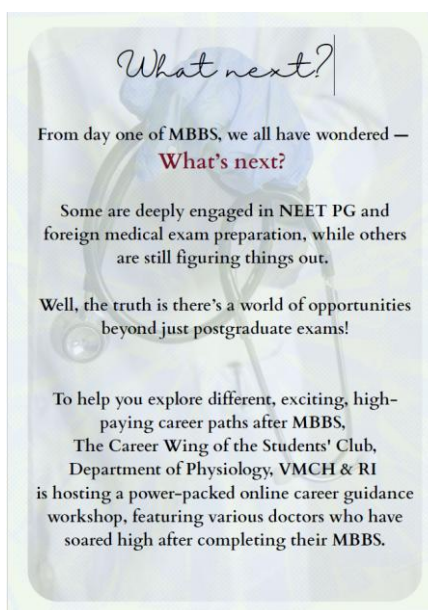
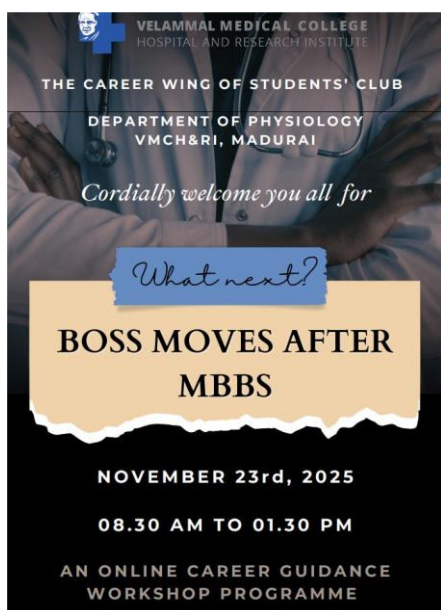

The career wing of Students' club under the Physiology department of Velammal medical college organized an ONLINE CAREER GUIDANCE WORKSHOP titled as "BOSS MOVES AFTER MBBS" on December 23rd, 2025. This workshop was open to all MBBS students and CRRIs across Tamil Nadu. 4 months before the workshop the google form for registration was circulated via social media platforms. Many undergraduate students joined the workshop virtually to get to know about various paths that remain unexplored, after completing MBBS.

The program commenced with a warm welcome address by Dr. A.R. Akshara, President of the Students Club. She emphasized the importance of career awareness among



medical students and encouraged participants to explore emerging and unconventional career opportunities after MBBS. She highlighted the need for informed decision-making and self-assessment in choosing a fulfilling professional path.

The first speaker was Dr. M. Guru Prakash - Occupational Physician & Medical Director, TVS Sundram Fasteners Ltd., Madurai. Dr. M. Guru Prakash delivered an insightful session on opportunities in Industrial Health and Occupational Medicine. He elaborated on the AFIH qualification, the role of occupational physicians in industries, workplace safety responsibilities, and career growth prospects. He also discussed work-life balance, remuneration, and the increasing demand for trained professionals in this field.

The second speaker was Dr. C. Madhan - MBBS, IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Thoothukudi Town. Dr. C. Madhan shared his inspiring journey from medicine to civil services. He explained the preparation strategy for UPSC, challenges faced during transition, and the broader impact doctors can create in administrative roles. Sir also answered to many of the queries raised by the students regarding UPSC preparations, UPSC's scope. Being an alumnus of our college some of the students had a chance to meet sir in- person at the hospital board room and had face to face interaction.

The third speaker was Sqn Ldr (Dr) S. Sudharsan - Medical Officer, Surya Kiran Aerobatic Team, Indian Air Force. Sqn Ldr (Dr) S. Sudharsan provided valuable insights into a career in the Armed Forces. He discussed the selection process, lifestyle, professional growth, and the honor associated with serving as a medical officer in the Indian Air Force. Both sessions motivated students to consider prestigious central government career opportunities.

The fourth speaker was Dr. Augustus Samuel Dodd - CEO, Grace Kennett Foundation. Dr. Augustus Samuel Dodd delivered an engaging talk on pursuing an MBA after MBBS. He explained how management education equips doctors with leadership, administrative, and entrepreneurial skills. He discussed opportunities in hospital administration, corporate leadership, and healthcare consulting, highlighting the growing integration of medicine and management.

The fifth speaker was Dr. S. P. Kausikan - Medical Officer, Government Hospital, Athoor, Dindigul. Dr. S. P. Kausikan provided comprehensive information regarding Tamil Nadu Government Medical Services. He discussed recruitment procedures, job security, career progression, postgraduate opportunities, and the responsibilities involved in public healthcare service. His session clarified various doubts regarding government employment after MBBS.

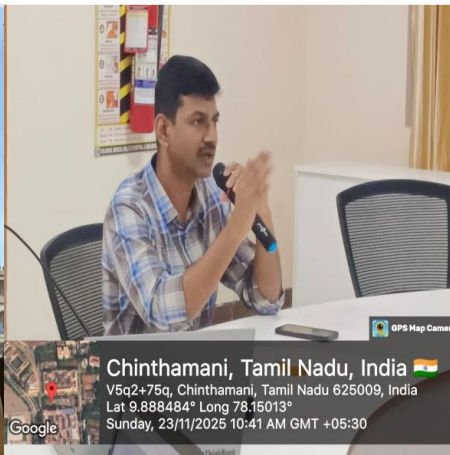

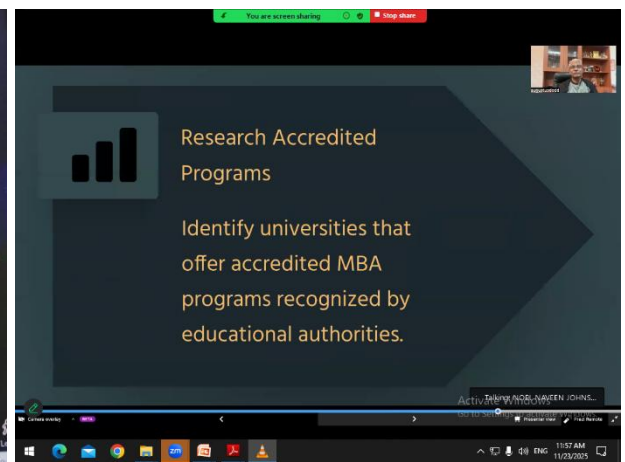
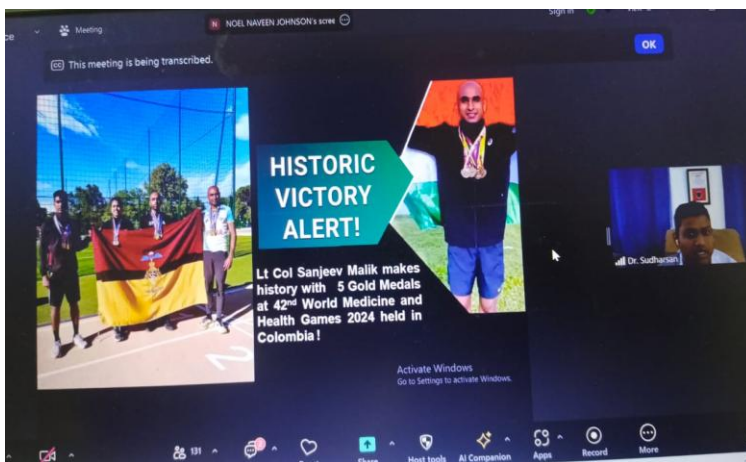
The speakers were felicitated by Dr S Anu, Professor and Head, Department of Physiology, Velammal medical college.
